Actions that help get you there!

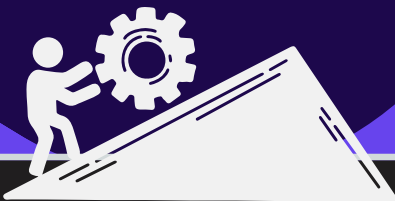
"Our faith does not make things easy, it makes them possible, inspiring us to press forward with the conviction that we can and will finish strong"



PREPARATION

Proverbs 4:7: "The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding."

Pre-reading before class provides a solid foundation of knowledge, allowing you to engage more deeply with the material. For example, previewing a chapter by connecting new vocabulary to processes or completing a concept map to help understand relationships between concepts.



ACTION NOTES

Proverbs 3:21 : "My son, do not let wisdom and understanding out of your sight, preserve sound judgment and discretion."

Careful noting and retention of wisdom provided during lecture to ensure you are capturing the details of "how" to think through the information presented.



STUDY

2 Timothy 2:15: Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

The diligence required in study to understand and apply knowledge accurately. Searching for information that is not clear and using the tools you have to gain clarity.



TEST PREPARATION

Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."

This is a form of study and homework in one action. Testing yourself by reworking problems or finding worksheets online, grading your answers and using the missed questions to guide your additional study.



GOING TO CLASS

James 1:19: "Everyone should be quick to listen...."

The importance of listening and thoughtful engagement in a learning environment will elevate your understanding.



REVIEW

Proverbs 10:13: "Hold on to instruction, do not let it go; guard it well, for it is your life."

Review and Discernment in what is essential, so that you can use the information taught to make good decisions. Practice makes the decision easier to make.



HOMEWORK

Colossians 3:23 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."

Dedication and effort in completing tasks such as homework to ensure your actions are reflective of your desire to honor the blessing of knowledge by testing your understanding
